School Uniform

Thank you for your patience over the summer holiday while we worked with our uniform supplier to get the new school logo on. PE Uniform

I will apologise now, however, in this section I have to have a little bit of a moan! Since early last year, we welcomed children into school in their PE uniform on PE days. This was to help ensure that children got the maximum time during their PE lessons to be active and learn the skills taught through Physical Education. Towards the end of last year and over the past two weeks I have seen a number of children on these days not wearing the correct PE uniform. Plimsolls or lightweight dark trainers for outside use


NEW BUILDING!
